
#### PMI Houston Gives \$250,000 Endowment to University of Houston

The Project Management Institute (PMI) Houston Chapter gave a \$250,000 endowment to the University of Houston College of Technology to establish a professorship in project management. This is the first endowment by PMI globally and the first professorship established by philanthropy specifically directed to UH's College of Technology. A reception announcing the establishment of the PMI Houston Professorship in Project Management was held at the University of Houston on September 29th.

UH achieved accreditation from the Project Management Institute in 2009. Currently, it's one of only 35 PMI accredited universities in the world, and one of only two in Texas. "It is with great pride we accept PMI's gift of \$250,000 on behalf of our college," said Dean William Fitzgibbon. "The Technology Project Management program in the college has increased significantly in popularity during the last four years. It has shown phenomenal growth and now ranks second highest among our college's graduate programs of study."

The endowment will provide permanent support to the University Project Management degree program, enriching the experiences of future project managers. "We look forward to continuing to support the University of Houston and the profession of project management," said John Gorman III, past president of the non-profit PMI - Houston Chapter.





# **ERIC JENETT**In Memoriam

#### **PMI Houston Lost A Close Fellow and A Founder Figure**

It is with deep sadness that PMI Houston Chapter announces the recent death of Eric Jenett, one of the five founders of the Project Management Institute and of our Houston chapter.

Mr. Jenett was PMI's president in 1971, chair in 1972 and secretary from 1975 to 1976. He was a founding member and former president and chair of the PMI Houston Chapter, which was PMI's first chapter. Mr. Jenett was honored by PMI in 1975 for his distinguished contributions to the Institute.

He presented at numerous PMI seminars and symposiums, served on a number of panels, and published a variety of articles in the *Project Management Quarterly*, later to become the *Project Management Journal*\*, and several other technical publications.

After receiving his master's degree in chemical engineering from Columbia University, Mr. Jenett spent the majority of his career with Brown and Root Corporation, now Kellog, Brown & Root, in Houston, Texas, USA. He retired in 1989 from his role as corporate vice president. During his career, he worked on a wide variety of project types in several countries.

The PMI Eric Jenett Project Management Excellence Award is named in his honor. He was 88.
